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SYNOPSIS

This investigation was initiated on June 30, 2009, by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Office of Investigations (OI), Region II (RII), to determine whether a former contract security officer, employed by Pinkerton Government Services (PGS), and working at the Watts Bar Nuclear Station (WBN), willfully failed to report an arrest to his management personnel or Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) officials.

Based upon the documentation and testimony developed during this investigation, OI:RII did not substantiate the allegation that a former security officer, employed by PGS, and working at WBN, willfully failed to report an arrest to his management personnel or TVA officials.
