Dear Mr. Varga:

On June 6, 1983, a revised 10 CFR Part 50 Appendix H, concerning material surveillance programs, was published. One of the requirements in Appendix H is to submit a summary technical report on the capsule within one year after withdrawal.

The most recent Indian Point Unit 2 reactor vessel surveillance capsule was withdrawn on November 6, 1982, at the end of Cycle 5. A report is normally prepared and submitted but there has in the past been no required date for submittal. Our projected date for submittal for this report, prior to the publication of revised Appendix H, was May 1984. Since the one year requirement was imposed seven months after capsule withdrawal, we are requesting an extension of six months, to May 6, 1984, to complete and submit the summary technical report.
