Dear Mr. Eisenhut:

Our response to Generic Letter No. 83-10d, submitted on April 15, 1983, presented a plan of action for resolution of TMI Action Item II.K.3.5, entitled, "Automatic Trip of Reactor Coolant Pumps". In this submittal we mentioned that a Westinghouse Owners Group(WOG) report concerning the justification for manual Reactor Coolant Pump(RCP) trip would be completed by the end of 1983.

We have recently been informed by the WOG that the date by which the report will be completed has now been revised to March 1, 1984. We continue to anticipate, as stated in our April 15, 1983 submittal, that within 120 days following receipt of the WOG report we will complete our assessment of the justification for treatment of manual RCP trip at Indian Point 2. This schedule supersedes the schedule provided in Attachment A of our April 15, 1983 submittal. We point out that a partial response on this matter has been transmitted to NRC (Sheppard to Mattson) by WOG letter No. OG-110 dated December 1, 1983.
