Dear Mr. Eisenhut:

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Your letter of December 27, 1984 (Generic Letter 84-24), received in this office on January 11, 1985, directed that we certify our compliance with 10 CFR 50.49, pursuant to 10 CFR 50.54(f).

During an April 19, 1984 meeting with your staff we discussed our general methodology for compliance with 10 CFR 50.49. Our letter of October 5, 1984 to Mr. Steven Varga described our overall environmental That program was established to ensure the qualification program. environmental qualification of electric equipment as set forth in 10 CFR 50.49, which includes reasonable assurance of the capability to shut down the reactor and maintain it in a safe shutdown condition. In addition, all other equipment within the scope of 10 CFR 50.49 has either been determined to be fully qualified, or a Justification for Continued Your staff's Safety Operation submitted pending full qualification. Resolution Final of Environmental entitled Evaluation Report, Oualification of Electric Equipment Important to Safety, and dated program complies with the December 7, 1984, concluded that our requirements of 10 CFR 50.49.

Inspection 27, 1984 letter also mentioned an and December Your Enforcement Bulletin and several Information Notices. I.E. Bulletin 82-04 (December 3, 1982) is not applicable to Indian Point Unit No. 2, as documented in my letter of April 4, 1983 to Mr. Richard DeYoung. In our 19, 1984 meeting we discussed our method of tracking and April documenting I.E. Information Notices at Indian Point Unit No. 2, and our evaluation of several of the Information Notices related to environmental Your staff and the I.E. members qualification listed in your letter. present at that meeting found our system to be fully acceptable. Through 19 Add: Shields (ELO) the system, we have evaluated and addressed each of the specific Information Notices in Generic Letter 84-24 (viz., I.E. Information Notice 82-11, 82-52, 83-45, 83-72, 84-23, 84-44, 84-47, 84-57, 84-68, 84-78). This system for evaluating and addressing IE Information Notices is still in place and it is our intent to continue it in the future.
