
Our submittal dated November 21, 1984 in response to the Order Modifying License dated September 27, 1984, included in our upgrade program a Health Physics appraisal scheduled for May 1985. A Health Physics appraisal is also scheduled for August 1985, as discussed at the enforcement conference on July 18, 1984.

Based on discussions among Con Edison staff and Region I staff during the week of March 18, 1985, we request that instead of conducting appraisals in May and August 1985, a single appraisal be conducted during September 1985. The detailed reviews currently being conducted by the Radiation Protection Oversight Committee fulfill the intent of the appraisal now scheduled for May 1985. In addition, the September appraisal would be more definitive than the earlier appraisals because it would follow the implementation of the upgraded Radiation Protection Program. A single appraisal will permit a more efficient allocation of resources.

The results of a September 1985 appraisal of the upgraded Radiation Protection Program would be provided to the Commission within the one year timetable originally established in the Order Modifying License.
