This is in response to your letter of March 7, 1985 requesting additional information following preliminary staff review of licensee responses to Generic Letter 83-28. Specifically you indicated that based on staff preliminary review, additional information would be necessary to assess the adequacy of Items 2.1 and 2.2.2 regarding vendor equipment technical information.

The Vendor Equipment Technical Information Program (VETIP), as defined in the March, 1984 Nuclear Utility Task Action Committee (NUTAC) document together with the positive interface program established with our NSSS vendor are considered valid responses to Item 2.1 and 2.2.2. A description of Con Edison's plan for implementation of the VETIP is described in our letter of March 4, 1985 along with a description of our positive interface program for NSSS supplied reactor trip system components (part 2 of Item 2.1). Accordingly, it is requested that NRC reconsider the March 7, 1985 request for additional information.
