SUBJECT: Evaluation of Manual Valves for Inclusion in the Inservice
Testing Program

This letter is to inform you of the current status and new projected
completion date of the subject matter.

As described in References 1 and 2, we had committed to an evaluation, by
May 31, 1989, of manual valve functions for the purpose of considering
whether further changes should be made to the scope of equipment included
in the Inservice Testing (IST) program.

Station procedures were reviewed to identify all manual valves cited in
instructions to change position during accident mitigation and plant
shutdown modes of operation. There were 517 such valves identified in
the Emergency Operating Procedures, Abnormal Operating Instructions and
Plant Operating Procedures. Because the procedure review identified more
valves than anticipated and because of the extensive repositioning of
valves identified, the second phase of our study can not be completed by
May 31.

With the benefit of this information now available, an additional study
will evaluate the role of each valve in terms of achieving plant shutdown
and accident mitigation. This determination is an essential element in
establishing the need for inclusion in the IST program. The completion
of this phase is currently projected to be accomplished by November 15,
1989.


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As stated in Reference 2, the final results of the manual valves evaluation will be incorporated into a future revision of the IST program summary, if necessary. This revision will be made within three months of completion of the study.
