

SUBJECT: Relief Request No. 29

By letter dated November 17, 1989, Con Edison requested that the NRC grant relief pursuant to 10 CFR 50.55 a(g)(6)(i) from strict interpretation of Code Case N-432 for a repair procedure. The basis for this relief request was the impracticality of achieving the code required toughness in a test specimen. We have determined that this circumstance also results in an inability to meet applicable ASME code requirements (Code Case N-432). Accordingly, we now amend Relief Request No. 29 to additionally seek relief pursuant to 10 CFR 50.55 a(a)(3).
