SUBJECT: Restructure of Emergency Planning Organization

The present Indian Point Unit 2 organization reflects an emergency planning group reporting to the Site Protection Manager who then reports directly to the Vice President for Nuclear Power. In order to reflect the more general Indian Point organizational structure, it is planned that the emergency planning group continue to report to the Site Protection Manager who will now report to the General Manager of Technical Services. The General Manager of Technical Services now reports to the Vice President of Nuclear Power and will continue to do so in the future.

The Site Protection Manager will continue to maintain management responsibility for Fire/Safety administration as well as site security.

Based on discussions with Region I staff we are submitting the proposed emergency planning organization for approval per the requirements of 10 CFR 50.54(q).
