FPL's Decision to Attend Regulatory Conference For NRC Inspection Report
05000335/2009006 and 5000389/2009006 Preliminary Greater the Green Findings

On January 19, 2010, the NRC issued the St Lucie Nuclear Plant – NRC Component Design Bases Inspection report. The inspection report documents 2 potentially greater than green findings associated with an October 2008 air intrusion event from the Unit 1 containment instrument air system into the component water cooling (CCW) system. The inspection report cover letter offered Florida Power & Light (FPL) the opportunity to request a regulator conference on the matter, and on January 28, 2010, FPL officially informed Mr. Kriss M. Kennedy of our intention to attend.

This letter provides followup notification that FPL plans to attend a regulatory conference on or about February 23, 2010, with the final date negotiated between FPL and the NRC. As requested, supporting documentation will be provided approximately one week prior to the conference.
