In letter dated September 22, 2009, you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive material license No. 12-16941-03. From the information you provided, it appears you possessed three iridium-192 radiographic sources model No. 424-9 each which were all last leak tested with negative results in May, and June, 2009 and disposed of by transfer in September 2010.

Based on this information, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required and your NRC license No. 12-16941-03 is hereby terminated.
