CONAM Inspection & ESI provides the following in accordance with our agreement established with the NRC during the alternative dispute resolution (ADR) session held on September 10, 2008. During the ADR Conam agreed to provide the NRC a summary of the safety conscious work environment (SCWE) survey results that was performed from February 18th – February 27th, 2009.

Conam, in cooperation with a third party organization, developed a survey in an effort to develop a baseline understanding of employee perception of our overall organizations culture and specifically safety culture. Further, I am pleased to present that we have excellent involvement with over 70% of our services workforce participating in the survey.

The survey considered our employees perspective related to methods established to report safety concerns, management's commitment to safety, management receptiveness to safety concerns, fear of retaliation, safety training, and peer checking to name a few. Additionally, it is important to note that the survey was conducted anonymously providing for open, honest and forthright feedback from our employees. Overall the feedback was highly positive with our safety culture/environment resulting in the highest marks relative to other cultural areas. However, while results were largely positive areas for improvement were noted. Specifically, Conam has realized opportunities to improve in the area of communications of weekly safety topics and safety meeting attendance.

In an effort to improve communication of safety topics Conam has commenced distributing periodic safety memorandums on internal experiences and opportunities for improvement. Further, Conam has commenced transmitting topics discussed during weekly General Manager (GM) conference calls to all locations to be shared with employees. During the weekly GM call topics may range from general safety to radiation. Finally, we are exploring the distribution of radiation safety violations as provided by the NRC in an effort to enhance awareness.
