The town of Wamsutter would like to take this opportunity to submit comments on the above referenced draft report.

Our comments specifically refer to section 4. 11 Socioeconomic Impacts as they relate to the community of Wamsutter, Wyoming. Wamsutter, located on Interstate 80, is the nearest livable community to the future work site.

We understand that the first phase of the Lost Creek ISR project will involve construction of the site. The Wamsutter community and its small retail and service businesses rely heavily on the influx of workers responding to the needs of the gas fields that surround the town. Therefore, what may be seen as an adverse impact to other communities actually assists our community through increased revenue locally.

The longer term production project provides the hope of a sustainable workforce to encourage our growing housing development, commercial development, planned infrastructure improvements, newly created health center and expansions to the Emergency Medical Services and Volunteer Fire Department.

Most of the socioeconomic impacts in the Environmental Impact Statement have been determined to be small or moderate. As a small community even a small impact makes a *very positive* effect on our businesses and residents.
