Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (Con Edison) transmitted by Reference 1 an "Application for Amendment to the Operating License" consisting of administrative changes to the Indian Point Unit No. 2 Technical Specifications (TS). A subsequent transmittal was provided via Reference 2 to re-transmit specific pages which had been provided without revision bars. Reference 3 provided additional changes to our amendment request that were administrative in nature. Specifically, the additional changes transmitted with Reference 3 pertain to IP-2 Technical Specification Sections 6.5.1.2 and 6.5.1.2.1 regarding the Station Nuclear Safety Committee member qualification requirements. Proposed Technical Specification Section 6.5.2.8 also requires revision to be consistent with the changes requested in Reference 1. Further, reference 3 requested an administrative title change to the Senior Vice President position. The attachment to Reference 3 provided the applicable reconciled pages to Technical Specification Sections 3.5, 3.9, 4.1, 4.2, 4.11, and 6.0 for your consideration. Subsequent to the transmittal of Reference 3, a corrected reconciled page 6-11 was transmitted on February 26, 1998.

Attachment I to this letter incorporates the applicable reconciled pages to Technical Specification Sections previously transmitted in the Reference 3 administrative change request, and includes those identified during our recent

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review of TS surveillance section requirements. Specifically, the applicable reconciled pages to Technical Specification Sections 3.5, 3.8, 3.9, 4.1, 4.2, 4.10, 4.11, and 6.0 are provided for your consideration. We request that the staff continue to process our application.

Attachment II provides the basis for the administrative changes or clarifications submitted by this supplement request.

The safety assessment of proposed changes previously submitted by Reference 1, Attachment II is not believed to be affected by the administrative changes set forth herein. As such, the proposed changes do not represent a significant hazards consideration as defined in 10 CFR50.92(c).
