Enclosed are two (2) copies of the complete scenario package for the Indian Point 3
Partial Participation Emergency Exercise scheduled to be conducted on October 13,
1994. Please note that this is a change from the previous date of October 5, 1994,
committed in reference 1. This letter, therefore, cancels commitment IPN-94-073-01.
Mutual agreement regarding this schedule change was reached between Mary Ann
Chaubard, Emergency Planning Coordinator, and you during a telephone conversation on
Thursday, July 28, 1994.

The scenario is submitted in accordance with the time frame set forth in NRC Inspection
Manual Procedure 82302, "Review of Exercise Objectives and Scenarios for Power
Reactors," dated March 18, 1994 and FEMA-REP-14, "Radiological Emergency
Preparedness Exercise Manual," dated September 1991.

The enclosed scenario has been validated on the simulator using current plant procedures. The simulator staff is currently correcting modeling discrepancies to enhance the reactor coolant system and the plant process computer system. The scenario team will be re-running the enclosed scenario on the simulator in September 1994 to ensure the scenario is still valid with the simulator corrections that have been made. If any scenario changes are required your office will be notified immediately.

In order to ensure scenario confidentiality, the Authority requests that the attached scenario be withheld from public disclosure until the exercise has been completed.
