Enclosed is a copy of the scenario package for the Indian Point 3 Partial Participation Emergency Exercise scheduled to be conducted on October 25, 1995. The scenario is submitted in accordance with the time frame set forth in NRC Inspection Manual Procedure 82302, "Review of Exercise Objectives and Scenarios for Power Reactors," dated March 18, 1994.

The enclosed scenario has been validated on the simulator using current plant procedures. The scenario will be re-run on the simulator in the September/October 1995 time frame to ensure that the scenario is still valid due to any simulator modifications that may be made between the date of this submittal and the date of the exercise. If any scenario changes are required, your office will be notified.

In order to ensure scenario confidentiality, the Authority requests that the attached scenario be withheld from public disclosure until the exercise has been completed.
