PURPOSE: The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) received a license renewal application (LRA) from Pacific Gas & Electric Company, dated November 23, 2009, for the renewal of the operating licenses for the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant, Units 1 and 2. The LRA is available at <http://www.nrc.gov/reactors/operating/licensing/renewal/applications/diablo-canyon.html> and in the Agencywide Document and Management System under accession numbers ML093340086, ML093350335, ML093340116, and ML093340123.

These meetings are being conducted as part of the scoping process outlined in Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* Part 51 to support development of an environmental impact statement related to the LRA. See the enclosed Agenda and *Federal Register* notice (75 FR 4427).

Both meetings will be preceded by an informal "open house" beginning one hour prior to each meeting. The open house will provide members of the public with an opportunity to talk informally with NRC staff.
