REFERENCE: Con Edison Letter dated June 6, 1994, S. Bram to  
Document Control Desk; Same Subject.

Pursuant to the referenced letter and discussions with NRC personnel (Region I), Con Edison proposes to perform a self-assessment of the Indian Point Unit 2 Service Water System as an alternative to an NRC performed Service Water System Operational Performance Inspection. This self-assessment will comply with the guidance contained in NRC Inspection Procedure 40501 and Temporary Instruction 2515/118.

We are currently evaluating self-assessments at other plants and are in the process of establishing a self-assessment plan which will be completed in August. This plan will address the self-assessment scope, objective, approach/methodology, organization and team member qualifications. The self-assessment team will be independent of the regular Indian Point Unit 2 staff and will possess the necessary qualifications to perform a technically creditable self-assessment. To assure this objective, the qualifications of external consultants and their possible participation as team members are being considered.

Upon completion of the self-assessment plan, copies will be forwarded to the NRC offices in anticipation of a formal presentation at Region I in September. This will provide an opportunity for NRC staff to assure themselves that the assessment will be conducted as an independent process and in accordance with NRC requirements. With the presumption of NRC approval in a matter of weeks, the actual assessment will be performed in October/November. Upon completion of the self-assessment, a final report will be issued and a presentation made to the NRC if so requested.


