
Subject: Submission of Simulator Facility Certification

This new replacement simulation facility complies with the applicable requirements of ANSI/ANS 3.5-1985 (as endorsed by NRC Regulatory Guide 1.149 Revision 1), and, in light of Section 5.2 of that ANSI Standard, this compliance is currently without exception.
