The purpose of this letter is to document notification made by our Test and Performance Manager to the Senior Resident Inspector - Indian Point 2 on August 25, 1997, of our preliminary determination that certain records associated with routine surveillance tests performed on emergency lighting installed pursuant to 10 CFR 50 Appendix R may be inaccurate. Specifically, we believed that certain steps in the test procedure may have been signed as completed when in fact they may have been incomplete or conducted in a manner not fully consistent with the test procedure. Our investigation, which substantiated our preliminary determination, was concluded on October 7, 1997. Results of the investigation and our actions will be provided to the Senior Resident Inspector.
