
SUBJECT: Response to Generic Letter 90-07,

Dear Mr. Perkins:

The attachment to this letter provides our schedules for initial operator licensing examinations and NRC requalification examinations, in response to Generic Letter 90-07. These are our current best estimates of our needs for examinations for FY1991, FY1992, FY1993 and FY1994 .

Please note, we have not scheduled a Requalification Examination by the NRC in 1991. As of December, 1990 approximately 46% of our operators will have been examined. There are 12 operators remaining with 1993 licenses. The scheduled operational date for the new Indian Point 2 simulator is in the first half of 1991. It is essential that operators receive sufficient training and experience on the new simulator to ensure operator familiarity with the upgraded models.
