SUBJECT: Re-Instatement of Senior Reactor Operator's License

This letter is being submitted by Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison") on behalf of Christopher Massaro, requesting re-instatement of his Senior Reactor Operator's License (SOP-11130) at Indian Point Unit 2. Pursuant to 10 CFR 55.47, the Con Edison also requests a waiver of the requirement for the applicant to pass a written examination and an operating test based on the information provided below.

Mr. Massaro's license was terminated upon his resignation in April 1997. Prior to his resignation, Mr. Massaro successfully passed the 1996 annual requalification exam and discharged his responsibilities competently and safely. Subsequent to his resignation, Mr. Massaro was re-employed by Con Edison in July 1997. Upon Mr. Massaro's re-employment, he successfully completed the licensed operator continuing training cycle missed during his absence.

To ensure that Mr. Massaro is up-to-date with regard to licensed activities, an annual requalification exam was administered to him in accordance with 10 CFR 55.59. The exam consisted of a comprehensive written exam and an annual operating test. The operating test consisted of two simulator scenarios and five job performance measures (JPMs). Mr. Massaro received an 89.6% on the written exam, passed both simulator scenarios and passed four of the five JPMs. Based on these results, Con Edison is satisfied that Mr. Massaro is up-to-date and can competently and safely discharge his responsibilities. Additionally, Con Edison requests a waiver of the performance of forty hours of shift functions pursuant to 10 CFR 55.53 as Mr. Massaro's license will not be active. If, however, Con Edison needs to activate Mr. Massaro's license, the requirements of 10 CFR 55.53 (f) will be satisfied.
