Dear Dr. Jackson:

At a meeting held in the Community Center in Woodstock, NY on May 11th, 1996 attended by over 100 people the following resolution concerning the Indian Point nuclear plant in Buchanan, NY was favored to be sent to you and other government officials and appointees.

Whereas, the two Indian Point generators have been shut down a number of times because of perceived dangers, and  
Whereas, a melt-down or any nuclear accident at Indian Point in Buchanan, New York would effect people in the Hudson Valley and in New York City in a Chernobyl-like scenario, and  
Whereas, one consequence of exposure to radiation is extreme illness often resulting in death.  
Therefore, we urge that the Indian Point reactors be shut down permanently and immediately.

We hope that you will conduct a thorough study of this matter and that you will honor us with a reply.





