SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AMENDMENT TO TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS - INDIAN POINT

NUCLEAR GENERATING UNIT NO. 3 (TAC NO. M96620)

Dear Mr. Knubel:

By letter dated September 6, 1996, as supplemented by letter dated June 6, 1997, you requested an amendment to the Indian Point Nuclear Generating unit No. 3 (IP3) Technical Specifications (TSs). The amendment would remove the requirement for the Plant Operating Review Committee (PORC) to review the fire protection program and implementing procedures.

On January 13, 1995, we issued Amendment No. 157 to the IP3 TSs. With Amendment No. 157 you relocated the fire protection TSs to the IP3 Operational Specifications Manual. In our safety evaluation for Amendment No. 157 we found the relocation of these TSs acceptable, in part, because you added TS 6.5.1.6.m calling for PORC review of the fire protection program.

In your September 6, 1996, and June 6, 1997, letters you justified the removal of PORC review the fire protection program and implementing procedures in part on Amendment No. 159 which shifted the review responsibility of nuclear safety-related procedures from the PORC to designated individuals and limited the PORC responsibilities to the review and approval of those procedures and procedure changes that are determined by these individuals to require a nuclear safety or an environmental impact evaluation. You proposed to extend this review and approval process for nuclear safety-related procedures and procedure changes to the fire protection program. Fire protection procedures and procedure changes, however, are not safety-related; therefore, nuclear safety-related evaluations do not apply to fire protection procedures and procedure changes.

The proposed deletion of PORC review of the fire protection program would remove specification 6.5.1.6.m added by Amendment No. 157. Since Amendment No. 157 was found acceptable, in part, because of the addition of TS 6.5.1.6.m, we cannot issue your amendment as requested.
