10 CFR Part 21 Interim Notification

Dear Sir:

Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 21 (10 CFR 21) requires that licensees evaluate deviations and failures to comply, and report those that could create a substantial safety hazard. Section 21 (a)(2) of 10 CFR 21 requires an interim report if a required evaluation cannot be completed within 60 days. This letter provides an interim report regarding information the Authority is evaluating.

The Authority received a Fisher Information Notice (FIN 94-03) which describes conditions that need to be evaluated for reportability under 10 CFR 21. The notice, and a supplement which followed, concern the use of the Fisher Type 3570 Series Positioners with Fisher Type 472 and 473 Spring Return Piston Actuators to achieve full travel, fail safe position.

Fisher recommended that licensees evaluate the information that was provided, and take any necessary actions to assure safe and reliable operation. The Authority is currently evaluating this information for Indian Point 3, but will not complete the evaluation within the required 60 days. The Authority will complete the evaluation by September 30, 1994. As required by 10 CFR 21, the Authority will notify the Nuclear Regulatory Commission if the evaluation concludes that any of the issues raised could create a substantial safety hazard.

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
