SUBJECT: MINUTES FROM NAP MEETING 94-12

NAP meeting 94-12 began at 9:30 a.m. on December 2, 1994, in the Region I Incident Response Center. Curt Cowgill opened the meeting by discussing the senior management tour at Indian Point 3 (IP3) on November 29 and 30, 1994. Messrs. Milhoan, Zimmerman and Martin toured the facility and held discussions with licensee personnel. The senior managers felt that their visit was successful.

Curt Cowgill discussed the NRC "road map" for IP3 restart and power ascension. Some pre-startup items to consider will be public meetings, and a possible revision to the Confirmatory Action Letter. Some post startup items to consider will be NRC coverage during restart, power ascension plateaus, our interactions with the utility, and possible self-assessments by the utility during or after power ascension. Curt Cowgill assigned NAP Action Item 94-12-01 to himself and Rick Urban to develop the approach for the NRC's startup plan; the open NAP Action Item List is attached. Bill Cook also pointed out that at some point we would need to NRC staff asking if there are concerns with allowing IP3 to restart.

Bill Cook discussed plant status at FitzPatrick. The unit is currently in a refueling outage that began on November 30, 1994. The reactor vessel head was currently being detensioned with 'A' RHR shutdown cooling in service. Major work to be done during the outage will consist of control rod drive refurbishment, inspection and repair to the core shroud, retubing the main condenser, and desludging the torus. The licensee is currently working on the emergency diesel generators and local leak rate tests.

Rick Rasmussen discussed the current plant status at IP3. The licensee is currently in the 32 emergency diesel generator window. The pressurizer is at 21% in preparation for PORV testing and safety injection motor operated valve (MOV) differential pressure testing. The licensee is also working on repairs to the carbon dioxide fire suppression system, service water concrete duct bank, and radiographs of six welds on the pressurizer. The panel discussed the status of the MOV reinspection in response to Mike Cases's question. The panel agreed that the MOV reinspection scheduled for January 30, 1995, should be scheduled earlier because it will interfere with the RATI. Curt Cowgill will discuss this issue with DRS.

Curt Cowgill discussed the November 17, 1994 public meeting held at the Cortlandt Town Hall with NYPA. Panel members thought that NYPA did a good job during their presentation. Due to the low turnout of local public citizens to the meeting, the NAP agreed not to hold any further public meetings during the evening unless future circumstances warrant a change.

Dave Lew discussed the status of the 59 NRC Restart Action Plan (RAP) Items. The licensee still owes 16 packages, 20 are closed, and 23 are currently under review with 6 of those scheduled to be inspected by the RATI.

Curt Cowgill discussed preparations for the next NAP meeting to be held in Headquarters on December 22, 1994. Senior managers planning to attend are Messrs. Russell, Miraglia, Thadani, Zimmerman, and Martin. Dave Lew will present an expanded IP3 plant status and Curt Cowgill will provide a history of NAP activities concerning IP3. Other agenda topics will include a status of RAP Items, the RATI plan, the NRC's approach to restart, and a status of the IP3 RAP. Panel members agreed that the RAP should be updated prior to the meeting. The meeting adjourned at 3:00 p.m.
