Dear Sir:

Enclosed is the Semi-Annual Report of Radioactivity in Solid Wastes and Releases of Radioactive Materials in Liquid and Gaseous Effluents for Indian Point 3 as required by Section 5.3.3.1 of the Environmental Technical Specifications. The enclosed report covers the period July 1, 1993 through December 31, 1993 for releases from Indian Point 3. Indian Point 2 has the capability to receive and process liquid waste from Indian Point 3. However, during this reporting period, no liquid waste was transferred to Unit 2. Annual meteorological and effluent dose data for calendar year 1993 is also included.

Additionally included in this report is a summary of airborne release data from 1980 to 1992, which includes a contribution from the Monitor Tank vent gaseous release pathway. This pathway was identified in 1993 and reported under LER 93-039-00. The Monitor Tank vent pathway did not significantly change the curies or dose previously reported.

Also attached is the commitment made by the Authority in this letter.
