Dear Mr. Denton:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. transmits herewith three (3) originals and forty (40) copies of a document entitled "Application for Amendment To Operating Licenses," sworn to on December 14, 1978. This Application requests an amendment to section 4.1.2a of the Environmental Technical Specification Requirements (ETSR) for Unit Nos. 1, 2 and 3 as set forth in Appendix B to Provisional Operating License No. DPR-5, Facility Operating License No. DPR-26, and Facility Operating License No. DPR-64, respectively. Minor amendments to sections 2.2.1.1., 3.2.1.1 and 5.6.1.2 of the ETSR which are necessary for conformance of these sections with the amendments for section 4.1.2a are also requested. These amendments would restructure the present intensive Aquatic Environmental Monitoring Program to a program for the continued long term monitoring and evaluation of impact of once through cooling operation.

In accordance with 10 CFR 170.22, this Application has been determined to be CLASS IV, as it contains amendments to the biological monitoring program that involve several changes of the CLASS III type deemed not to involve a significant hazards consideration. Therefore, as required by regulation, enclosed is a check in the amount of \$13,100.00 as the filing fee. This payment is being made under protest, and Con Edison




