

Dear Mr. Cohen:

The purpose of this letter is to request your written confirmation of information received from USNRC Region I pertaining to Emergency Notification System (ENS) and Health Physics Network (HPN) telecommunication circuits for the alternate emergency response facility for the Indian Point nuclear plant site in Buchanan, New York.

Pursuant to the specific guidance found in the Region I Incident Response Supplement to NUREG-0845 and a letter from Mr. Ronald C. Haynes, NRC Region I to Mr. John D. O'Toole dated January 8, 1983 (EPL 83-01) we submitted a letter dated August 9, 1984 to Mr. Edward Wojnas of Region I (attached) requesting additional communications circuits for the Con Edison Alternate Emergency Operations Facility (AEOF). In a telephone conversation held on October 31, 1984, Mr. Fred Karp of my staff was informed by Messrs. Amato and Wojnas of Region I that NRC's present policy, developed in conjunction with NRC Telecommunications Branch, is not to make emergency communications circuits such as ENS and HPN available to licensee's alternate ERFs, and that such facilities are to rely on existing communications capabilities. We would appreciate written confirmation of this for our files. Should you have any questions please contact me.
