
This letter is being provided in response to your June 27, 1980 letter which forwarded IE Bulletin No. 80-16. This bulletin requested information regarding Rosemount Inc. Models 1151 and 1152 Pressure Transmitters with either "A" or "D" output codes used in safety related systems in the Indian Point Units Nos. 1 and 2 plants.

With respect to Indian Point Unit No. 1, the unit was shut down on October 31, 1974 and is presently in the defueled condition. It has been determined that the subject of this bulletin is not applicable to Indian Point Unit No. 1.

With respect to Indian Point Unit No. 2 there are no installed Rosemount Inc. Models 1151 and 1152 Pressure Transmitters with either "A" or "D" output codes in safety related systems. There are no plans to install such transmitters at Indian Point Unit No. 2.
