By letter dated November 24, 1980, we acknowledged receipt of IE Bulletin 80-23, "Failures of Solenoid Valves Manufactured by Valcor Engineering Corporation" dated November 14, 1980.

With respect to the action requested of licensees by the bulletin, please be advised that our review indicates that there are no Valcor solenoid valves having P/N's V70900-21-1 or -3 installed or intended for installation in systems performing safety-related functions at Indian Point Unit No. 2. With regard to Indian Point Unit No. 1, the plant was shutdown on October 31, 1974 and is presently in the defueled condition and is no longer licensed to operate as a reactor. The subject of this bulletin is therefore not applicable to Unit No. 1.
