The Commission* met to continue the July 23 discussion of
issues requiring resolution prior to issuance of an order
in the Indian Point special proceeding.

The Commission requested:

1. data describing the uncertainty in the curves shown in
Figure 2, p. 335 of the October 24, 1983 Board decision
on Indian Point and a discussion of the factors that are
taken into account by these curves; and
2. population distribution curves for local nuclear power
plant sites, including Indian Point and other sites with
a range of population densities from low to medium to
high.

The Commission requested a staff briefing on probabilistic
risk assessment (PRA), particularly PRA on Indian Point.
This briefing should include a discussion of uncertainties
and the basis for comparison in the PRA's.
