Subject: Request for additional information concerning the bankruptcy.

Dr. King spoke to me concerning some issues regarding the bankruptcy since the licensee is tentatively scheduled to cease to exist in late March and a Trustee will take over at that point. Dr. King wanted to know if an RSO was required when the licensee went into receivership. I confirmed that a person needed to be named as RSO when the licensee went into receivership. If he would no longer be able to perform the duties of the RSO then a member of the Trustees would need to be named. The NRC would also need to have contact information for the named individual. Dr. King understood that the property could not be sold without NRC written clearance but wanted to know about the equipment. I informed Dr. King that any equipment that was contaminated with Carbon-14 or Tritium would need to be released for unrestricted use just like the property. Any equipment contaminated with short half-lived material could be free released once surveyed and found to be not contaminated. Dr. King indicated that he would get back in touch with me if he had any further questions.
