Dear Sir,

I am in favor of continued operation of the Indian Point nuclear power plants.

My judgement is based on the following facts:

- a) The Indian Point reactors supply nearly 20% of the generation capacity for N.Y.C. and Westchester County. Without them we run more risk of blackout.
- b) With Indian Point Reactors running, Con Ed. and PASNY can shut-off oil-fired plant. Not only lowering the cost of electricity, but also helping the energy independence which means we don't have to depend on foreign oils.
- c) Some people are talking about converting the Indian Point Reactors to coal-burning. This will result in increased environmental damage and increased radioactive emissions.

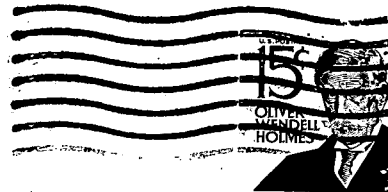
Please keep Indian Point Reactors Operating because we need it.
