Dear Mr. Smith

On June 18, 1979 Mr. Stan Wisla, Chemistry and Radiation Safety Director at our Indian Point Nuclear Facility, received a telephone call from Region I Inspector John Serabian. Mr. Serabian inquired if we had submitted the necessary reports pursuant to the Commission's letter of May 4, 1979. Mr. Wisla advised Mr. Serabian that no reports to the Commission were required at this time and that he believed all actions required by the May 4, 1979 letter had been completed. Mr. Serabian was also informed that the 3.3 rem whole body exposure had been assigned to the individual as directed. Mr. Serabian indicated that he would inform us the following day whether or not the Commission would require any further reports.

On June 19, 1979 Mr. Serabian called and informed us that a report pursuant to 10CFR20.405 was required. We emphasized in our conversations that all the information required by 10CFR20.405 had been previously submitted in our March 21, 1979 response to the Commission's Combined Inspection Report No. 50-003/78 - 13;50-247/78-38.

We are submitting this letter as notice of our previous compliance with the requirements of 10CFR20.405. Your inspector became aware of the identity of the individual involved during the course of the combined inspection cited above. We reiterate that the further information required by 10CFR20.405 was submitted to you in our letter of March 21, 1979. That information, in conjunction with your directive of May 4, should therefore be deemed to be a report pursuant to Section 20.405. To preserve this individual's right to privacy, it is respectfully requested that his identity be withheld from public disclosure.

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To assure the completeness of your records, a listing of the required identifying information and copies of the letters cited above, are enclosed.
