2) Physical Description

This shipment consists of 1 x 20' container loaded with 661 x Gd UO₂ rods packed into 6 x Traveller packages, USA/9297/AF-96 Rev 2. RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL, Type A Package, Fissile. Total net weight of U is 1,554 kgs. The net weight of U-235 is 53 kgs.

3) Transportation and Route Schedule
