



Annual Environmental Protection Plan Report
For the 1991 Calendar Year Pursuant To
Appendix B to Facility Operating Licenses
Indian Point Unit Nos. 1, 2, and 3

Subsection 5.4.1 of Appendix B to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (the "NRC") Facility Operating Licenses for Indian Point Unit Nos. 1, 2, (issued April 24, 1981) and 3 (issued May 26, 1981), requires that an Annual Environmental Protection Plan Report (the "Report") describing implementation of the facilities' Environmental Protection Plan (the "EPP") for the previous year be submitted to the NRC prior to May 1 of each year. This Report is for the 1991 calendar year.

Subsection 5.4.1 of Appendix B specifies that the Report shall include summaries and analyses of the results of any environmental protection activities (environmental monitoring) required by Subsection 4.2 of the EPP for the reporting period. Since Subsection 4.2 specifies that no environmental monitoring is required, no summaries or analyses are provided herein.

Subsection 5.4.1 of Appendix B also specifies that the Report shall include:

- A. A list of EPP noncompliances and the corrective actions taken to remedy them.

Response: During the calendar year 1991 there were no EPP non-compliances at Indian Point Units 1, 2, or 3.

- B. A list of all changes in station design or operation, tests, and experiments made in accordance with Subsection 3.1 which involved a potentially significant unreviewed environmental issue.

Response: During Calendar year 1991, there were no changes in station design or operation, tests and experiments made in accordance with Subsection 3.1 which involved any other potentially significant unreviewed environmental issue at Indian Point Units 1, 2 or 3.

- C. A list of non-routine reports submitted in accordance with Subsection 5.4.2.

Response: During calendar year 1991 there were no non-routine reports submitted pursuant to Section 5.4.2 for Indian Point Units 1, 2, or 3.

2. State Certification
