DATED NOVEMBER 23, 2009

On November 23, 2009, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued Order EA-09-204 (the Order) to Dominion Nuclear Connecticut, Inc. (DNC) imposing increased controls for Millstone Power Station Unit 1. The Order imposes requirements on licensees possessing specified radioactive material quantities of concern. In a December 17, 2009 letter (Serial No. 09-755), DNC submitted a request for an extension of time to submit its Answer and response to the Order until February 15, 2010. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission approved the extension in a January 20, 2010 letter.


