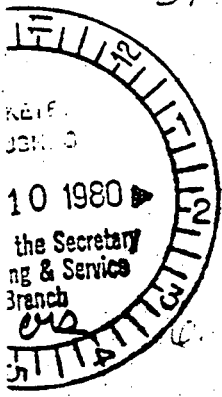

Dear Mr. Ahearn,

I would like to request the following:

1. That you please revert Harold Denton's decision not to shut down Indian Point nuclear power plant
2. That an atomic safety + licensing board be set up
3. That a factual record be compiled by this board on the items in the Union of Concerned Scientists petition.
4. That this be done through adjudicatory hearings to become the means of providing procedural safeguards.
5. That the commissioners be the ones to make the decision on the Union of Concerned Scientists petition - not the licensing board which should only be for fact gathering.
6. That there be a suspension of plant operation until the commissioners have made their final decision
7. That hearings be held in the affected radius of the plant so we can be there
8. That this be done with all speed - before it is too late - THE LIVES OF FIFTEEN-MILLION PEOPLE are in jeopardy.
