By letter to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) dated October 23, 2008 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System Accession No. ML083100149), Exelon Generation Company, LLC, submitted a request to replace the current accident source term used in design-basis radiological analysis with an alternative source term pursuant to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 50.67, "Accident Source Term," for the LaSalle County Station, Units 1 and 2.

The NRC staff is reviewing your submittal and has determined that additional information is required to complete the review. The specific information requested is addressed in the enclosure to this letter. During a discussion with your staff on February 18, 2010, it was agreed that you would provide a response on April 2, 2010.

## DOCKET NOS. 50-373 AND 50-374

In reviewing the Exelon Generation Company's (Exelon's) submittal dated October 23, 2008 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML083100149), related to the request to replace the current accident source term used in design-basis radiological analysis with an alternative source term pursuant to Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations Part 50.67, "Accident Source Term," for the LaSalle County Station (LSCS), Units 1 and 2, and the licensee's supplement dated November 18, 2009 (ADAMS Accession No. ML093220838), the Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff has determined that the following information is needed in order to complete its review:

## Electrical Engineering Branch

- 1. The following question is in reference to request for information (RAI) Question #2 response, found in the licensee's letter dated November 18, 2009. Describe changes to the emergency diesel generator (EDG) surveillance testing and how the surveillance testing demonstrates the EDG capability to supply the necessary accident loading given that Division 1 loads now require use of the EDG's 2000 hour rating. In addition, describe EDG design load margin in more detail and how that design margin is managed.
- 2. The following question is in reference to RAI #5 response, found in the licensee's letter dated November 18, 2009. Based on your response, a subset of the components for the standby liquid control system is in a harsh environment due to high radiation which would necessitate inclusion in the 50.49, "Environmental qualification of electric equipment important to safety for nuclear power plants," program. Confirm that these components are in the 50.49 program or provide a detailed justification why they should not be.
