Call title/subject: Update on incidence of primary amoebic meningoencephalitis (PAM) and other water-borne diseases in Matagorda County, Texas.

Purpose of call: Provide information on PAM and other water-borne disease that are of concern in Matagorda County.

Call notes:

- Ms. Aston contacted Ms. Moody on behalf of Amoret Bunn (PNNL) to find out details of the recent cases of primary amoebic meningoencephalitis (PAM) in Texas since the last CDC publication on the topic by in 2008 (MMWR 57(21): 573-577). She also asked Ms. Moody which water-borne diseases are of most concern in Matagorda County and whether or not they are/were recreationally related cases.
- Ms. Moody said there were 2 cases in 2007 and 1 case in 2008, all three from the same water body, Lake LBJ in Burnet County, Texas.
- Ms. Moody said she would research both questions and respond via email on 1/11/10.
