APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT
TO OPERATING LICENSE

Pursuant to Section 50.90 of the Regulations of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC"), Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison"), as holder of Facility Operating License No. DPR-26, hereby applies for amendment of the Technical Specifications contained in Appendix A of that license. Specifically Con Edison requests a one-time technical specification change to definition 1.2.1, Cold Shutdown Condition, to reflect a defined value for Tavg of $\leq 250^{\circ}\text{F}$, instead of $\leq 200^{\circ}\text{F}$, for the fuel-out full reactor coolant system (RCS) chemical decontamination program only. This would also concomitantly increase the cut off temperature for Hot Shutdown from $>200^{\circ}\text{F}$ to $>250^{\circ}\text{F}$ as well. During the implementation of this program, RCS temperature excursions up to 240°F will occur. This change will eliminate unnecessary technical specification actions during the decontamination process for RCS temperature above 200°F . The decontamination activity will be effected during the plant's scheduled 1995 refueling outage, and will be conducted in accordance with the requirements of the NRC approved Westinghouse generic topical report WCAP-12932-A Rev. 2, Full Reactor Coolant System Decontamination Program.

The specific proposed Technical Specification revisions are set forth in Attachment A to this Application. A Safety Assessment of the proposed changes is set forth in Attachment B to this Application. This assessment demonstrates that the proposed changes do not represent a significant hazards considerations as defined in 10 CFR 50.92(c).

As required by 10 CFR 50.91(b)(1), a copy of this application and our analysis concluding that the proposed changes do not constitute a significant hazards consideration have been provided to the appropriate New York State official designated to receive such amendments.
