
SUBJECT: Proposed Amendment to Technical Specifications  
Regarding Boron Monitor Tanks Level Monitoring  
Requirements (TAC No. M88039)

Our letter dated September 29, 1993 requested an amendment to the Indian Point Unit 2 Technical Specifications. This amendment would eliminate the requirements associated with the retired, empty boron monitor tanks. As part of the amendment request, three proposed amended pages were submitted. Since the submittal, one of these pages has been changed due to the NRC's approval on December 16, 1993 of Amendment No. 166. Therefore, enclosed is a new proposed amended page (Table 4.10-2, page 1 of 2) which has been updated to include Amendment No. 166. The other two pages remain valid as is.

Since the updated page only reflects an unrelated previously approved Amendment, this change is editorial, and has no effect on the previously submitted application, including its Safety Assessment and No Significant Hazards Analysis.
