
SUBJECT: License Amendment No. 169

The subject amendment was issued by NRC letter dated April 28, 1994. Although the amendment was effective as of the date of its issuance, it was to be implemented after the inlet and outlet lines of the numbers 21, 22 and 23 Boron Monitor Tanks were cut and capped.

This letter provides notification to the NRC that this piping was cut and capped as of August 4, 1994, thereby achieving permanent mechanical isolation of the three tanks. Therefore, the license amendment has been implemented, and was issued under controlled distribution on August 16, 1994.
