This letter is in regards to your amendment request dated February 5, 2010. In your letter you stated "Tracerco is requesting that license condition 17 be amended or a new license condition added, verifying the acceptance of the Pasquill-Gifford Atmospheric Dispersion Model for determining 10 CFR 20.1302 compliance." The issue of compliance with 10 CFR 20.1302 is not handled through the licensing process, but rather a compliance issue which is reviewed during NRC inspections. Therefore, an amendment for your license is not required for you to continue using the Pasquill-Gifford Atmospheric Dispersion Model.
