10 CFR 35.63 requires a licensee to determine and record the activity of each dosage before medical use and to retain records of the dosage determination in accordance with 10 CFR 35.2063. 10 CFR 35.2063 requires records must contain certain information including the prescribed dosage, the determined dosage, and the date and time of the dosage determined. Contrary to the above, from July 1, 2009 to Jan 25, 2010, the administered dosages were determined but not always recorded. The licensee committed, effective January 26, 2010, to include in records per 35.2063 the dosage administered to patients.
