I am very concerned and upset with the operations of the Cintichem Nuclear Facility in Sterling Forest and their past history of violations in releasing contaminated water into the nearby Indian Kill Reservoir.

I hereby request a complete report of your findings as a result of DEC's investigation and inspection to date.

I want to make sure that the people in the community are fully protected and its drinking water completely safe before Cintichem resumes its operations.

I am requesting that a public hearing be held and a complete environmental impact statement be done in accordance with Article 8 of the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act prior to any renewal of its liquid waste emissions permit (SPDES).

Please apprise my office and all county and local officials of the date and place for the public hearing regarding this application.
