Here are my editorial comments:

- SECY paper, page 2, Discussion section, para. 6 - spell out NARM first. I believe it's the first time it is mentioned in the paper.
- Federal Register Notice, page 1, Background section, para. 1 - to be consistent (b) should read: byproduct materials as defined in Section 11e.(2) of the Act
- FRN, page 7, para.2, 3rd sentence - states "The technical staff are working with NRC-license reviewers in the NRC Region I office..." This is not really happening at this time. It may happen prior to the effective date of the Agreement but hasn't happened yet. It is true that inspectors are accompanying NRC staff on inspections. You may want to reword the licensing part to reflect that they plan to work with NRC license reviewers. I'll leave it up to you. No real heartburn over this but wanted to let you know.
