Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2010-01 requested information with respect to the number and complexity of licensing requests expected to be submitted in Fiscal Year (FY) 2012 to assist the NRC in determining FY 2012 resources and budget needs. Information regarding construction plans and schedules for fabrication of large components and modules was also requested to be submitted when available.

Listed below are STPNOC's anticipated significant submittals for Fiscal Year 2012.

- Technical Specification upgrade amendment to include all appropriate Technical Specifications Task Force (TSTF) Travelers approved since design certification, including the Risk Informed Initiative TSTF Travelers.
- Relief request regarding use of plastic pipe in the Reactor Service Water System
- License amendment request regarding nuclear fuel upgrade
- License amendment request regarding extended power uprate
- Request for approval of Design Control Document Tier 2\* Codes and Standards updates to more current editions and revisions.

STPNOC submitted the proprietary STP 3 & 4 construction schedule information to the NRC on February 25, 2010 (U7-C-STP-NRC-100053). Updated schedule information will be submitted, as appropriate, during the preconstruction and construction process.
