By letter dated February 22, 2010, QSA Global, Inc. (QSA) submitted its responses to the staff's request for additional information (RAI) dated October 1, 2009. QSA also submitted a consolidated Safety Analysis Report for this application, including changes related to staff's 10 CFR 71.95 evaluation report dated October 28, 2009, further to a September 21, 2009, notification by QSA, and requested that the package review include consideration of NUREG-1886, "Joint Canada-United States Guide for Approval of Type B(U) and Fissile Material Transportation Packages."

This letter acknowledges receipt of your application and informs you that the application appears to contain the necessary information to begin our technical review. We have established a schedule for this review which allows for the staff to issue RAIs in April 2010, with the revised Certificate of Compliance (CoC) scheduled to be issued in June 2010. In accordance with NUREG-1886, the review will be coordinated with the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission and the U.S. Department of Transportation.
